
POLICY DIALOGUE DAY:

THEME: *"The climate of Africa in 2021: Trends, impacts and Early Warning system for building resilience in Africa"*

THE AFRICAN CENTRE OF METEOROLOGICAL APPLICATIONS FOR DEVELOPMENT (ACMAD), THE AFRICAN UNION COMMISSION, THE WORLD METEOROLOGICAL ORGANIZATION, THE UNDRR, THE INTERNATIONAL CENTRE FOR ENVI-RONMENTAL MONITORING (CIMA-ITALY) AND OTHER PARTNERS ARE STRENGTHENING CAPACITY IN AFRICA TO DELIV-ER CLIMATE CHANGE AND MULTI-HAZARDS EARLY WARNING INFORMATION FOR CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTATION AND DISASTER RISK REDUCTION.

A CONTINENTAL MULTI HAZARD ADVISORY CENTRE IS ESTABLISHED AT ACMAD TO SUPPORT THE SITUATION ROOM BASED AT AUC IN ADDIS ABABA WITH REGULAR CONTINENTAL HAZARDS AND DISASTER SITUATION REPORTS, CONTI-NENTAL CLIMATE TRENDS AND IMPACTS AS WELL AS IMPACT-BASED ADVISORIES AND WATCHES. THE SITUATION ROOM USES SITUATION REPORTS, ADVISORIES, OUTLOOKS AND WATCHES FOR COMMUNICATION AND DISCUSSIONS TOWARDS PLANNING AND UPDATE OF EMERGENCY PREPARATION AND RESPONSE MEASURES AND ACTIONS.

The launch of the continental multi hazards advisory Centre is a component of the modernization of Early warning systems in Africa. Climate trends and impacts, multi hazards outlooks, advisories and watches will be presented as principal services of the Centre. The Centre will support National Meteorological Services and other national stakeholders during hazard seasons to deliver warnings and support well informed preparation and response actions.
