

















STATE OF AFRICA'S CLIMATE IN 2021: HAZARDS, TRENDS AND IMPACTS

THE 2022 UNFCCC COP 27 WILL BE ORGANIZED IN SHARM EL CHEIKH, EGYPT, 7-18 NOVEMBER 2022 TO DISCUSS IMPLEMENTATION OF COMMITMENTS MADE AT COP 26 PARTICULARLY ON THE YEARLY REVIEW OF NATIONALLY DETERMINED CONTRIBUTIONS TO TACKLE CLIMATE CHANGE. POLICY MAKERS, NEGOTIATORS AND LEADERS FROM PRIVATE SECTOR, SCIENCE AND CIVIL SOCIETY WILL PARTICIPATE.

COP 27 WILL BE A PREMIER VENUE TO SHARE THE FINDINGS IN THIS REPORT WITH AFRICAN NEGOTIATORS AND POLICY MAKERS PROVIDING SCIENCE-BASED INFORMATION FOR NEGOTIATIONS AND DEBATES ON CLIMATE ACTION. A CONTINENTAL TECHNICAL COORDINATION MECHANISM INVOLVING WMO AND REGIONAL CLIMATE CENTRES IN AFRICA WAS SET UP TO PREPARE AND PRESENT THE ANNUAL STATE OF CLIMATE REPORT FOR AFRICA. THIS SIDE EVENT WILL SHOWCASE THE PRODUCTS HIGHLIGHTING THE RESULTS OF COORDINATED WORK ON THE STATE OF CLIMATE TAKING AFRICA'S INTEGRATION AGENDA FORWARD IN THE FIELD OF CLIMATE ACTION.
